

TDOT Announces West Knoxville Corridor Strategy

Comprehensive Approach to Improve Safety and Mobility

- Next 18-24 months, TDOT will invest in preliminary engineering to determine what corridor improvements need to be made.
- Preliminary engineering will focus on significant enhancements to the 17-mile corridor where I-40/I-75 are joined and includes the Watt Rd & Campbell Station Rd interchanges, both **weigh stations**, and the potential for future choice lanes.
- Initial investment of approx. \$115M, which does not represent the full cost. TDOT is developing a strategy for funding by leveraging dollars and applying for discretionary grant opportunities in which we think this project is a strong candidate.





TDOT FY 25-27 Comprehensive Multimodal Program

- Anderson SR-170 from Oak Ridge Hwy to near Melton Lake Dr ROW FY-25
- Anderson SR-170 from near Melton Lake Dr to Clinton Hwy ROW FY-25
- Knox I-40 Corridor Priority Investment Project PE FY-25 & PE FY-27
- Knox I-75 Emory Rd Interchange CN FY-25
- Loudon I-75 Rural I-75 widening from Exit 81 to I-40 PE FY-25 & CN FY-27
- Various other resurfacing, bridges, safety improvements, and transit funding
