2. Motion to Recommend Approval of an Amendment to the FY 2016-2017 Transportation Planning Work Program (TPWP)

Item Summary: Staff is recommending 3 additional transportation related studies/planning efforts as well as increased FTA Section 5303 planning funds to be added to Task III of the FY2017 TPO Transportation Planning Work Program.

Discussion: Jeff Welch reviewed the proposed Amendment noting these funds need to be allocated by the end of the calendar year, further noting that the [FY 2016-2017] Work Program needs to be amended to add these additional funds. He then touched on the 3 studies included in the prosed Amendment: the first, the Alcoa Downtown Concept Planning Study, a master development plan for guiding redevelopment of the former Alcoa, Inc. West Plant site, updating an earlier study, the second, the Maryville Greenway Connection Study to assess the feasibility of improving pedestrian connections between schools, parks and existing greenways in the City of Maryville and the third, for the KAT/TPO Transit Routing Software as a Service, for an off-the-shelf web-based geospatial mapping tool that streamlines multi-step functions of the operations planning process by providing various instant information and analyses. Including State and Local Matches for \$70,500.00 each and \$564,000.00 of FTA Section 5303 dollars staff is recommending adding a total of \$705,000.00 to the Work Program.

A Motion was made by Gerald Green and seconded by Brian Boone to recommend approval of an Amendment to the FY 2016-2017 Transportation Planning Work Program. The Motion carried unanimously.
