This study will include design work and how to prioritize any recommended improvements in relation to the TDOT's 10-Year Project Plan. TDOT goal is to develop a holistic strategy for improving the corridor instead of a series of independent improvements. TDOT staff and its consultants will provide an update of the study and its progress.
