Modification also updates project schedules, programs phases previously anticipated to be obligated from the previous TIP and programs congressionally directed funding for Demo ID TN285 (Blount County Greenway Ph. 1) and TN 286 (Knoxville South Waterfront Ped./Bike Bridge). This modification adds \$22,577,190 (\$7,057,752 federal L-STBG/\$5,040,000 federal L-STBG-TA/\$3,500,000 federal HIP/\$1,664,000 federal CRP/\$950,000 state MMAG/\$4,365,438 local) to the grouping and TIP. The total grouping cost is increased to \$38,291,203. Please see the following and attached information summarizing a proposed modification for the Bike and Pedestrian Grouping for the FY 2023-2026 Knoxville TPO TIP to add two state STBG-TA projects for Knox County.

This modification adds two projects to grouping. Construction is programmed for the Gibbs Schools Pedestrian Bridge in FY 2025 at a cost of \$2,422,918 S-STBG-TA (\$1,938,334 federal/\$484,584 local). Construction is programmed for the Powell HS Greenway in FY 2025 at a cost of \$1,924,825 S-STBG-TA (\$1,539,860 federal/\$384,965 local). This modification adds \$4,347,743 (\$3,478,194 federal S-STBG-TA/\$869,549 local) to the grouping and TIP. The total grouping cost is increased to \$42,638,946.

The modification will be entered in the eTIP to generate a modification #, but will be queued until items previously entered are cleared from the system. While on that subject, I'll take this opportunity to again point out that the eTIP system is so far achieving the opposite of the intended purpose of reducing the time to process TIP modifications/amendments. I'll remain on that soapbox until the matter is resolved.
